Reading Power with Adrienne Gear - Continuing the Journey into Effective Comprehension Instruction

Since that time, Reading Power strategies and the "language of thinking" has been integrated into classrooms and schools across the province. In this session, Adrienne will reflect on how Reading Power has evolved over the years including the key concepts, links to curriculum. She will attempt to clear up some misconceptions that have developed. She will address the similarities and differences between Fiction and Nonfiction Reading Power and review the strategies for each. Adrienne will share a few favourite lessons from each of her Fiction and Nonfiction books and of course, there will be many great new book titles to view! Come to this session and be re-charged and re-inspired to integrate Reading Power into your classroom. Participants will receive black line masters of the shared lessons and an updated bibliography.

Vancouver Kidsbooks will be on site selling both of Adrienne's books and many of the titles she will be sharing.
